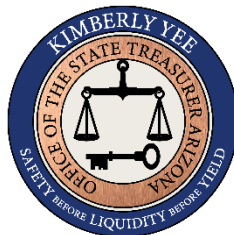

Per §A.R.S. 36-2856, Section D1, 33% shall be distributed to community college districts and provisional community college districts.

**Section D1(a):** 15% of the 33% shall be divided equally between each community college district.

**Section D1(b):** 0.50% of the 33% shall be divided equally between each provisional community college district.

**Section D1(c):** The remainder (17.5%) to community college districts and provisional community college districts in proportion to each district’s full-time equivalent student enrollment percentage (FTSE).
